RE: PROPOSED HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENTS TO COPROLITE STREET, IPSWICH

Ipswich Borough Council, under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Act 1984 is to implement a road closure for Neptune Quay and Coprolite Street between 11th February and 12th March 2013. When the road closure is in operation, every effort will be made to maintain access for authorised users, such as residents, pedestrians, cyclists and delivery vehicles, but minor delays may be encountered.

The reason for the closure is to ensure that our contractors are able to work safely as the carriageway width is not adequate to achieve a safe working zone if Coprolite Street remains live to traffic. To remove the danger and conflict between passing vehicular traffic with the workforce and pedestrians, it is necessary to close the road. Due to Coprolite Street being the only exit for Neptune Quay, it was necessary to reduce the number of vehicles using this stretch of the Quay, by allowing restricted passage for authorised users only. An alternative exit for Neptune Quay can be gained via the proposed diversion route which will be signed for the above duration.

A plan showing the proposed works and diversion route can be viewed on Ipswich Borough Council's web-site www.ipswich.gov.uk/consultations. Alternatively a hard copy of the drawing can be posted to you upon request.
